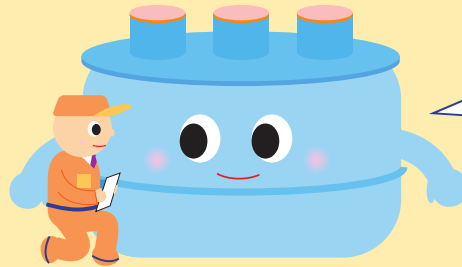


Inspection, Cleaning, and Testing of Purification Tanks (Joukasou) are Legally Required.

Carry Out Regular Maintenance Inspections

(Article 10 of the Purification Tank Act)

〈To Implement:〉
Please request a maintenance contractor registered with the city.
Please contact the office listed on the other side of this paper.



〈Maintenance inspection means:〉
Inspection of motors and other parts, performance check of the purification tank, adjustment of sludge, and inspection and replenishment of disinfectants

〈Penalty〉 If purification tank maintenance and inspections are not carried out as mandated, you may be subject to imprisonment for up to six months or a fine of up to one million yen. (Article 62 of the Purification Tank Act)

Carry Out Cleaning Regularly

(Article 10 of the Purification Tank Act)

〈To Implement:〉
Please request service from the purification tank cleaning company responsible for your area.
If unsure, please contact the office listed on the other side of this paper.



〈Cleaning in this context means:〉
Removing accumulated sludge, scum, and other waste from inside the purification tank and keeping the tank clean.

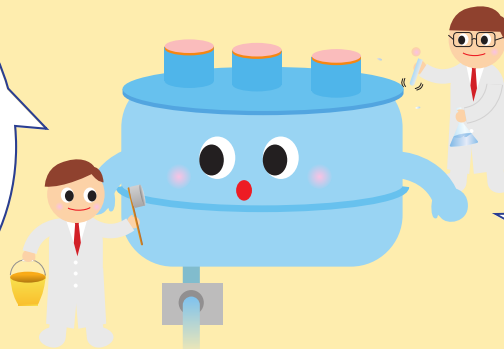
Carry it out at **least once a year.**

〈Penalty〉 If purification tank cleaning is not carried out as mandated, you may be subject to imprisonment for up to 6 months or a fine of up to one million yen. (Article 62 of the Purification Tank Act)

Carry Out Statutory Inspections

(Articles 7 and 11 of the Purification Tank Act)

〈To Implement:〉
Please request service from an inspection organization designated by the prefectural governor.

〈Statutory Inspection means〉
Inspection of water quality conducted by a public organization

First Inspection (Article 7)
Within 4 to 8 months after starting use
Second and Subsequent Inspections (Article 11)
Once a year

〈Penalty〉 If statutory inspections of purification tanks are not carried out as mandated, you may be subject to a civil fine of up to 300 thousand yen. (Article 66-2 of the Purification Tank Act)
